Full members of the AACBT receive the quarterly journal *Behaviour Change*. This is a recognised scientific journal that presents articles addressing clinical, research and professional issues. There are regular special issues that highlight significant areas of research and clinical practice with international and local contributors.

Workshops

AACBT Victoria offers high quality workshops on a wide range of topics. Workshops are open for any person to attend, with substantial discounts to members. Workshops are facilitated by recognised national and international experts in a range of fields. In recent years we have hosted workshops by Paul Salkovskis, Leslie Greenberg, Jeffrey Young, David M. National Conference

The AACBT organises an annual National Conference, which is hosted by a different state branch each year. Prominent international and national researchers and practitioners are invited to attend as keynote speakers and presenters. There are opportunities for members to meet colleagues with similar interests and develop professional networks. The 33rd National AACBT Conference will be held Melbourne, from 17-20 April, 2010.

Awards and Prizes

The AACBT National Committee also offers the Tracey Goodall Early Career Award, which comes with a \$2000 prize, and the Distinguished Career Award each year. Both awards come with a plaque and are presented at the National Conference.

Professional Development Points

AACBT activities typically receive 1 Professional Development point per hour (General and relevant specialist colleges points) from the Australian Psychological Society.
